



WEBINAR ON PERSONALIZED MEDICINES

On dated 10.06.2021 School of Pharmacy, Abhilashi University organized a webinar on the Role of Drug Discovery for Future Generation. Dr. R.K Abhilashi, Chancellor, Abhilashi University inaugurated the program. More than 100 academicians, professionals, and Ph.D scholars from different Universities /colleges across the country participated in this scientific webinar. Vice-Chancellor Prof. H.S Banyal emphasized that advancements in genotyping are improving transplant outcomes and dramatically improving our ability to predict the potential for a patient to experience severe hypersensitivity reactions to a drug. He also discussed translating new personalized knowledge about medicines. pharmacogenomic biomarkers into routine clinical practice has become reality rather than a futuristic vision. Speaker, Dr. Kamal Singh Rathore, Prof. & Head (Dept. of Pharmaceutics), B.N College of Pharmacy, B.N University, Udaipur said that changes in medical technology provide an opportunity for the patients and the healthcare provider to know the risk

of disease, response to the therapy, and benefit from more targeted and effective treatment. Further he added that we will have to incorporate technology in



reading and research over time. This is the need of the hour. The field of science and genetics allows us to develop effective, safe medications and doses tailored to an individual's genetic makeup what we call today "targeted therapy" which is either small-molecule drugs or monoclonal antibodies. At the end of the webinar, the experts resolved the queries of teachers and research students. The program was ended with a vote of thanks by the Dean, School of Pharmacy.

SCHOOL OF PHARMACY CONDUCTED ONLINE PLACEMENT


Macleods Pharmaceuticals Ltd, Baddi, Himachal Pradesh conducted an on-line recruitment drive for B. Pharmacy students.




