Feedback is vital part of teaching and learning process. It helps the mentor to recognize that how the students know his/her subject being taught. This is a significant where can get better his/her teaching methodology that will finally benefit the student. Introspection and constructive criticism are the key to refinement of any process. This principle finds more relevance in a learning set up where the success of any pedagogical system, the feedback from students becomes a critical determinant of the quality of teaching. Abhilashi University, Chail Chowk, Mandi, H.P. being unique from its very inception and foundation, has emerged as a benchmark of excellence and innovation for the world of education. With quality sustenance as its focus, the IQAC of the university has developed the feedback mechanism commencing with obtaining feedback from the students, teaching staff every session for continuous improvement in curriculum development and enrichment. There is a comprehensive mechanism of obtaining the feedback and it involves three phases.

Feedback Proforma

The feedback is collected in a proforma meticulously designed by IOAC. It comprises of questionnaire carrying a number of objective questions related to various aspects of the university. Most of the questions require a precise reply about various aspects of the college on a rating scale in order to procure quantitative data which can be processed further. For certain questions, the feedback is entertained in the form of remarks which constitute qualitative data. The feedback is collected from following sources:

(I) Students:

This is the most important part of feedback and is what matters the most in framing the policies of the institute. The biggest concern is the opinion of students about the quality of teachers, their study and university general facilities as transportation, safe drinking water, hostel, internet, Mess, Sports etc.

(II) Teachers:

Teachers have traditionally been the pivot od ancient educational system but in the modern student-centric setting the role of teachers has undergone a paradigm shift. Now they are views as facilitators and are required to mold their teaching in accordance with the preferences of students. Teachers' feedback has been found to influence their relationships with students and students' outcomes, including their academic engagement and aspects of their self-perceptions. This makes the feedback from teachers critically important in understanding the quality of teaching in university and in devising policies accordingly. Therefore, Abhilashi University, Chail-Chowk, Mandi, H.P. has made elaborate efforts to obtain comprehensive feedback from teachers on various points such as syllabus standard, consonance, addition and deletion.

This is a significant where can get better his/her teaching methodology that will finally benefit the student. Introspection and constructive criticism is the key to refinement of any process. This principle finds more relevance in a learning set up where the success of any pedagogical system, the feedback from students becomes a critical determinant of the quality of teaching. (II) Teachers:

Now they are views as facilitators and are required to mould their teaching in accordance with the preferences of students. FEEDBACK SYSTEM 2020-21

Feedback is vital part of teaching and learning process. It helps the mentor to recognize that how the students know his/her subject being taught. This is a significant where can get better his/her teaching methodology that will finally benefit the student. Introspection and constructive criticism is the key to refinement of any process. This principle finds more relevance in a learning set up where the success of any pedagogical system, the feedback from students becomes a critical determinant of the quality of teaching. Abhilashi University, Chail Chowk, Mandi, H.P. being unique from its very inception and foundation, has emerged as a benchmark of excellence and innovation for the world of education. With quality sustenance as its focus, the IQAC of the university has developed the feedback mechanism commencing with obtaining feedback from the students, teaching staff every session for continuous improvement in curriculum development and enrichment. There is a comprehensive mechanism of obtaining the feedback and it involves three phases.

Feedback Proforma

The feedback is collected in a proforma meticulously designed by IQAC. It comprises of questionnaire carrying a number of objective questions related to various aspects of the university. Most of the questions require a precise reply about various aspects of the college on a rating scale in order to procure quantitative data which can be processed further. For certain questions, the feedback is entertained in the form of remarks which constitute qualitative data. The feedback is collected from following sources:

(I) Students:

This is the most important part of feedback and is what matters the most in framing the policies of the institute. The biggest concern is the opinion of students about the quality of teachers, their study and university general facilities as transportation, safe drinking water, hostel, internet, Mess, Sports etc.

(II) Teachers:

Teachers have traditionally been the pivot od ancient educational system but in the modern student-centric setting the role of teachers has undergone a paradigm shift. Now they are views as facilitators and are required to mould their teaching in accordance with the preferences of students. Teachers' feedback has been found to influence their relationships with students and students' outcomes, including their academic engagement and aspects of their self-perceptions. This makes the feedback from teachers critically important in understanding the quality of teaching in university and in devising policies accordingly. Therefore, Abhilashi University, Chail Chowk, Mandi, H.P. has made elaborate efforts to obtain comprehensive feedback from teachers on various points such as syllabus standard, consonance, addition and deletion.

(III) Alumni: We are collecting feedback from our Alumni personally. We have designed a special feedback form on curriculum development. We are also collecting feedback from Alumni on Course Content, Teaching Learning Process, Curriculum /Syllabus / Evaluation process, Library/ Sports/others and Administration. It is the tradition of the college to involve alumni in its activities. We believe that alumni feedback is an important source of information for betterment and development of the institution.

(IV)Employer's Feedback: Employee are major stakeholders, feedback of whom gives us input regarding enhancing the employability of our students. We have collected feedback from the employers where we ask our employee to comment on the curriculum. They felt that the curriculum enriches the knowledge on application of discipline subjects, principles and concepts. The curriculum is helpful to develop critical thinking ability and creativity. The feedback from the university alumni is also obtained on well-structured proforma. The proforma is provided to students and in-class feedback from students was collected. The student's feedback is:

Anonymous-To encourage honest feedback without fear of reprisal from anyone.

In class- To ensure high rate of participation.

Objective- To permit data summarization and analysis.

Students Feedback regarding General Facilities:

General facility for the students is one of the most important aspects of any educational organization. Abhilashi University has six various Faculties in which the students are studying in different courses. 
Faculty Feedback Regarding Syllabus:
