### Terms and conditions for running of the courses

The running of the existing as well as new courses is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The University shall seek prior approval for admission norms to BAMS for the academic year 2016-17 form the State Government.
- 2. The approval for existing as well as new courses is on the specific condition that faculty and physical academic infrastructure must be in place before the issue of prospectus. The University shall indicate in the prospectus the following information for the information of the students, general public and State Govt.:
  - a. Names and academic bio-data of faculty available for each course.
  - b. Physical academic infrastructure must find mention in the prospectus.
  - c. Course wise seats approved indicating the seats reserved for the scheduled caste/scheduled tribes/ physically handicapped and himachali candidates.
  - d. Fee structure approved for each course.
  - e. Scholarship scheme(s) if any.

- f. Duration of each course and course structure.
- g. Admission criteria for each course.

The university shall be required to supply a copy of the Prospectus to the Commission/State Govt. before it starts issue of the same for the academic session 2016-17. Further, the above information should be available on the website of the University indicating details of faculty along with their photos and bio-data. The information regarding admission disclosure, examinations schedule, students passed out, faculty and academic infrastructure etc. must be furnished from time to time to the Regulatory Commission in the manner as required.

- 3. The availability of faculty as per norms & physical academic infrastructure, course structure/curriculum and preparedness of the University for running the courses shall be subjected to inspection before commencement of academic session 2016-17 by the Inspection Committee(s) to be constituted for the purpose and it shall be open to the Commission to withdraw the approval, if any deficiencies are noticed.
- 4. In case University is unable to meet the faculty and physical infrastructure norms and the university is of the view that it is unable to run the course, an intimation to this effect be submitted to the Commission at least one month before the commencement of the academic session. However, course(s) once started shall have to run for at least three years continuously and the university shall ensure the availability of full faculty strength and physical academic infrastructure based on approved intake as per norms for the course(s).

- 5. The eligibility and admission criteria for admission to the above courses shall be as prescribed by the concerned Regulatory Bodies and the State Government. Admission through migration mode in the first year not meeting the eligibility criteria shall be treated as invalid and subject to penal action as per HPPERC Rule, 2011. Admissions of foreign students be regulated as per AICTE Notification No.F.37-3/Legal/2004 dated 21.01.2004 circulated to All State Private Universities vide Commission letter No. HPPERC/55/General Complaints/2012-704 to 719 dated 07.08.2014. The AICTE guidelines regarding admission under lateral entry be followed in letter and spirit. The UGC guidelines regarding providing 3 % reservation in all courses to the persons with disabilities circulated vide this office letter No. HPPERC/73/Notification/2012-952 to 967 dated 08.09.2014 be also followed meticulously. Admissions, if any, made in violation of the prescribed norms, shall be invalid and degrees awarded to such candidates shall not be recognised besides attracting action as may be called for.
- 6. The universities should submit the proposal(s) for fee fixation to the State Government in respect of courses mentioned at I and II before 31.12.2016 as per statutory requirements. A copy of such proposal should invariably be sent to the Commission.
- The university shall comply with "Mandatory Assessment and Accreditation of Higher Education Institutions" Regulation, 2012.
- 8. The University shall strictly comply with the UGC (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulation, 2003 and engage faculty as per the norms fixed by the regulatory bodies viz. UGC, AICTE, BCI, MCI etc. The University shall observe at least the minimum standard of instructions and prescribed norms for the running of a course/ programme/ grant of degree which shall be imparted by a duly qualified teaching staff and appropriate academic physical infrastructure facilities as prescribed.
- 9. The University shall ensure submission of requisite information to the UGC as required under Sections 3.7 & 3.8 of U.G.C. (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulation, 2003 which inter-alia requires sending of intimation to the U.G.C, six months prior to starting of a new course. Where the U.G.C. inspection is overdue, the University shall ensure submission of requisite information to the U.G.C. in the prescribed format at the earliest so that inspection could take place.

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- 10. If, any course(s)/ degree(s)/ programme(s) is being run or is/ are to be run by the University, which has/ have not been approved by the UGC/ other regulatory bodies, the same shall be liable for cancellation without any notice and no future correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- 11. If any information provided is found incorrect at any stage or the assurances provided regarding meeting the norms of faculty and infrastructure in respect of all courses or in the event of violation of standards of admission, charging of excess fees than approved or indulging in practices which are not in conformity with the prescribed regulations, the Regulatory Commission reserves its right to withdraw the approval and take such action, as it may deem fit.

You are requested to take further necessary action in the matter and keep the Commission apprised of the same.

The approved fee structure for M.Phil./Ph.D. for the academic session 2017-18 must find mention in the advertisement/ prospectus/ website of the university.
- The UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulation 2016, shall have to be adhered to in letter and spirit.

- 3. Students shall be enrolled against the approved seats only after holding entrance test conducted at the level of the university for which proper advertisement shall be issued indicating inter-alia the course wise seats earmarked for the students of reserved categories.
- The University shall have to constitute Research Degree Committee if not already done and minutes thereof invariably uploaded on the University's website.
- The M.Phil. /Ph.D. seats not filled during the academic session 2016-17 against approved intake shall not be carried forward to the next academic session.

If at any stage, it is found that the aforesaid conditions are not being complied with, the Commission reserves the right to withdraw the approval.

Further the Inspection Committee is also of the view that the University must purchase Anti Plagiarism software so that their writing work could be adjudged at primary stage of writing. Further, the University is advised to provide appropriate budget for research programmes in different departments in order to facilitate the research work to be carried out by the scholars in the near future. All the departments were also found to be in urgent need of Non-Teaching staff / helpers/ laboratory assistants in order to facilitate the faculty members and research scholars. The research scholar must be encouraged for attending seminars, conferences regularly for which the University must provide financial support to them. Teaching fraternity must be allowed to attend FDP, refresher courses, seminars, conferences regularly for which the University must provide financial support to faculty. Each department must organize a National/ International conference every year. But in order to encourage the research work by the students and teachers and to maintain continuity for the future research scope through Ph.D. scholars (as and when seats granted for the Ph.D.), some seats of M. Phil. were recommended to be granted by the members of the committee. The Committee members were also of the view that if the said University establishes the appropriate infrastructure including research equipment, journals etc. and recruit qualified faculty wherever required / pointed out, the request for granting Ph.D. seats can be considered for the Academic Session 2018-19 next times.



Course(s) once started shall have to be run for at least three years continuously and the university shall ensure the availability of full faculty strength and physical academic infrastructure as per approved intake as per norms for the course(s).
- The eligibility and admission criteria for admission to the above courses shall be as prescribed by the concerned Regulatory Bodies and the State Government. Admission through migration mode in the first year not meeting the eligibility criteria shall be treated as invalid and subject to penal action as per HPPERC Rules, 2011.
- Admission of foreign students be regulated as per AICTE Notification No.F.37-3/Legal/2004 dated 21.01.2004 circulated to All State Private Universities vide Commission letter No. HPPERC/55/General Complaints/2012-704 to 719 dated 07.08.2014 and subsequent orders issued in this regard.

#### 7. Admission on the basis of test conducted by H-PUMA shall not be allowed at all.

- 8. AICTE guidelines regarding admission under lateral entry be followed in letter and spirit.
- 9. Where University has dropped / closed programme / proposed zero-intake / break in Extension of approval be obtained for closure of the programme from AICTE in terms of Section 1.6 of the Approval Process Hand Book 2018-19 or as directed in the latest edition of the Approval Process Hand Book.

- 10. UGC guidelines regarding providing 3 % reservation in all courses to the persons with disabilities circulated vide this office letter No. HPPERC/73/Notification/2012-952 to 967 dated 08 09.2014 be also followed meticulously.
- 11. Any admissions, made in violation of the prescribed norms shall be invalid and will attract provisions contained in HP-PERC Act, 2010 and Rules framed thereunder. The inference of this may also be incorporated in the Prospectus of the University so as to avoid any complication at a later stage.
- 12. The University to get fee approved from the State Government including hostel charges, convocation participation charges, and fee to be charged for in absentia degree etc. as per statutory requirements. A copy of such proposal should invariably be sent to the Commission.
- The University shall comply with "Mandatory Assessment and Accreditation of Higher Education Institutions" Regulations, 2012.
- In case of Research Degree (Masters and Doctoral) Programmes roster for allotment of students to supervisor must be followed and number be adhered to as per UGC guidelines.
- 15. The University shall strictly comply with the UGC (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 and engage faculty as per the norms fixed by the regulatory bodies viz. UGC, AICTE, BCI, MCI, PCI, NCI, CCIM, AYUSH etc. The University shall observe all the standards of instructions and prescribed norms for the running of a course/ programme/ grant of degree which shall be imparted by a duly qualified teaching staff and appropriate academic physical infrastructure facilities as prescribed.
- 16. The University shall ensure submission of requisite information to the UGC as required under Sections 3.7 & 3.8 of U.G.C. (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 which inter-alia requires sending of intimation to the U.G.C, six months prior to starting of a new course. Where the U.G.C. inspection is overdue, the University shall ensure submission of requisite information to the U.G.C. in the prescribed format at the earliest so that inspection could take place.
- 17. If, any course(s)/ degree(s)/ programme(s) is being run or is/ are to be run by the University which has/ have not been approved by the UGC/ other regulatory bodies, the same shall be liable for cancellation without any notice and no future correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- 18. If any information provided is found incorrect at any stage or the assurances provided regarding meeting the norms of faculty and infrastructure in respect of all approved courses is not fulfilled or in the event of violation of standards of admission, charging of excess fees than approved or indulging in practices which are not in conformity with the prescribed regulations, the Regulatory Commission reserves the right to withdraw the approval and take such action, as it may deem fit.
- 19. No student should be admitted on the condition that his/her fees will be deducted from scholarship amount granted under SC/ST category by govt. of HP. Any violation found in this regard will impose penal action on University.

20. All the Government norms in all respects be followed in letter and spirit.
