The following points were discussed and decisions arrived at:

**1. Change of course code Numbers.**

The members of the Board of Studies (BOS) agreed to allot Course Code Number AU Agron 124 to Practical Crop Production (PCP) course which was introduced in the course catalogue during the Second Semester of Academic Year 2014-15. Accordingly, the changes in the Course Code Numbers in all the courses of Agronomy discipline were made and approved. The change is recommended to the Academic Council for approval.

**2. Approval of course contents of Experiential Learning.**

The course contents of Experiential Learning (elective courses) to be allotted in 8<sup>th</sup> semester were framed, finalized and Course Code Numbers were allotted. The same is recommended to the Academic Council for approval.

**3. Shifting of Experiential Learning from 8<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> semester & vice-versa and approval of the change of course code numbers accordingly.**

The following decisions were taken:

- i. The Board of Studies (BOS) finalized the proposal of shifting Experiential Learning courses from 7<sup>th</sup> semester to 8<sup>th</sup> semester keeping in view the accommodation problems which the students may face during 7<sup>th</sup> semester and sufficient time which a student requires for competing in various competitive examinations towards the end of degree course.
- ii. It was felt by the Board that the abbreviation given in the code is too lengthy, which should be shortened. Accordingly the abbreviations were shortened. The relevant changes in the Course Codes and Numbers have been made.
- iii. It was further felt by the Board that the students should have wider experience not only of the elective but also that of the allied elective. Accordingly it was recommended that in place of offering all the 20 Cr. Hrs from one single elective, he should offer 12-14 Cr. Hrs. of major elective and remaining 6-8 Cr. Hrs from the allied electives.

**The proposals are recommended to the Academic Council for approval.**

**4. Starting of M.Sc. Agriculture classes.**

The Board of Studies (BOS) agreed to the proposal to start M.Sc. programmes in three disciplines viz. Agronomy, Soil Science and Plant Pathology. However, the BOS desired that before starting any PG programme the following minimum requirements are required to be met.

- There should be at least minimum of three faculty members in each programme.
- Number of seats should be less than five in each field of specialization.

> The stability of the faculty members must be ensured so as to avoid inconvenience among the students.

## The proceedings of 17<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Academic Council held at 02:30 PM on 15/06/2017 in the Conference Hall of Ayurveda Block.

At the outset, the Member Secretary of the Council welcomed the Chairman and all the members present in the meeting and thereafter with the permission of the Chair, the agenda items were taken up one by one.

### **Item No. 1: Statement of the Chairman.**

The Hon'ble Chairman also welcomed all the members present in the meeting thereafter, apprised them about the latest and the ensuing activities of the university as well as laid stress on some actions that are required for further improvement of the quality of education in the University.

(a) End of Even Semester. The Hon'ble Chairman has apprised all the members that the even semester is ending and the practicals and end term examinations are going on. After the examinations, the students shall remain on semester break from 01/07/2017 to 31/07/2017. The faculty members shall only proceed on semester break after the declaration of results. Therefore, he desired that the marking of the answer sheets should be done at priority and result compiled so that the semester breaks could be planned.

(b) Commencement of Classes of the Next Academic Session. The Hon'ble Chairman apprised all the members that the classes of the next academic session would commence from 01<sup>st</sup> Aug, 2017. He desired that all the Labs, classrooms,

teaching plans, lesson plans and the time tables for all the classes should be prepared before proceeding on semester break. Further, he desired that all the Coordinators and In-Charges of the respective schools should work out the requirement of chemicals, books, equipment, furniture and faculty for the next academic session and submit the same to him for procurement and recruitment of the faculty respectively.

- (c) Planning of Seminars, conferences and workshops. The Hon'ble Chairman apprised all the members that Seminars, conferences or workshops have been organized by the Schools of Ayurveda, Engineering & Technology and Pharmacy during this semester, therefore, he desires that the Schools of Agriculture, Basic Sciences and Management should plan and organize Seminars, conferences or workshops in next semester. Further, he desired that eminent scholars should be invited for these activities for the benefits of students and faculty of the University.
- (d) Fee for Next Semester. The Hon'ble Chairman apprised all the members that it has been observed by him that some of the students do not pay the fee of the semester in time and a lot of correspondence is done for realizing the fee from such students which results into wastage of time and efforts. Therefore, he desires that all the coordinators and In-Charges of all the Schools should counsel the students of their respective schools to pay fee before the commencement of classes failing which such students should be debarred from the classes.
- (e) Preparation for Inspections. The Hon'ble Chairman laid stress that all the Coordinators/In-Charges and faculty of the respective schools should prepare for the inspection of their school and get the inspections done at their own without looking towards the office of the Vice-Chancellor or Management as was being done in the past.
- (f) Revision of Syllabi. The Hon'ble Chairman apprised all about the directions of the University Grants Commission regarding revision of syllabi in every three years. He informed all the members that as the University is going to complete three years of its existence, therefore, it is mandatory to revise all the syllabi of all courses. Hence, he desired that all the syllabi of all the courses should be revised within next three months.
- (g) Project: The Hon'ble Chairman apprised all the members that State Council for Science Technology and Environment H.P. has invited proposals for H.P. Specific Research and Development Projects up to 10 Lac. The last date of receipt of such proposal is 14/07/2017; therefore, all the coordinators/In-Charges of the Schools should submit such projects after approval of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to the quarter concerned before the aforementioned date.

**Item No. 2: Approval of action taken report of the proceedings of 16<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council.**

The member secretary laid before the council, the action taken report of 16<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council and the same was approved by the Council unanimously.

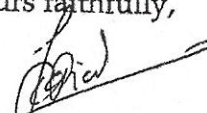

**Item No. 1 Statement of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor:**

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor being the chairman of the Academic Council welcomed all the members of its worthy members present to this 26<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Council. The Hon'ble Chairman apprised the Academic Council about the following activities of the University:-

- Examination:** The Hon'ble Chairman brought to the notice of the members present in the meeting that the end term/ semester examinations had been completed between 16/05/2018 and 25/06/2018. However, the schedule for courses under annual examination remains the same as notified earlier in the Academic Calendar. The students would be on summer break from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2018 and the classes would commence from 01/08/2018. However, classes of the first Year Diploma in Veterinary Pharmacist students under two years Annual System would begin from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2018 followed by summer vacation during 15<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2018. All the Deans should inform the students accordingly.

2. **FDP:** The Hon'ble Chairman brought to the notice of the members present in the meeting that the Faculty Development Programme for the University teachers would be conducted by Dean/HOD in the School of Engineering & Technology from 29/06/2018 to 30/06/2018 as decided under item No. 16 in the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Deans Committee held on 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2018.

3. **Admissions.** Since management of Abhilashi University has provided sufficient infrastructural facilities under all undergoing courses, efforts must be made to increase admissions and promote awareness amongst the stakeholders. The Hon'ble Chairman apprised all the members about the dates of various entrance tests for the various courses of the University. He also desired that all the members should make sincere efforts at their own level and through faculty as well as students of their Faculty for motivating prospective students for taking admission in the University. Further, he stressed that the students of the University are the best ambassadors and all the members should involve students in admissions specifically. Therefore, Teachers, Non-teaching Staff, and Students were addressed in the Multi-Purpose Hall to educate them about the latest eligibility conditions and Fee Structure etc.

4. **Prospectus:** Vice- Chancellor informed the members that Prospectus-2018-19 carrying details of academic calendar, courses, eligibility for admissions, infrastructural, library, hostels, transport, and other facilities related information has been published for the benefit of students, admission committees, teachers and Deans of all faculties, schools and departments.

5. **Commencement of Academic Session 2018-19.** The Hon'ble Chairman apprised all the members that the academic session 2018-19 would commence from 01/08/2018 depending on the Semester and Annual Systems. All the Deans/HODs/Incharge should make all arrangements for admissions, registration and commencement of classes accordingly. Further, they should ensure proper arrangement of class rooms, labs, books, registers, stocks, equipments, chemicals, time-tables, lesson plans etc. in time.

6. **Results:** Honorable Chairman apprised the Council that the over-all result of the end semester examinations held in June, 2017 stood at 76.77 per cent, while in December, 2017 examination, it stood at 65.29 per cent. Similarly, the average over-all result of out-going students under different courses in June, 2018 stood at 90.57 per cent. He, further, informed the members about the meritorious achievements by students & faculties in

the university whom he appreciated and thanked for the involvement and performance.

**7. Other Information:** Chairman was also pleased to inform the Council that Abhilashi University completed its publications in time which include Annual Reports, News Letters, Pamphlets, prospectus etc. Further, he informed that the university adopted and implemented several state and national sponsored schemes & programs. Swachhata Abhiyaan in the selected villages & Towns under Swach Bharat Mission was organized and practiced. Similarly, Earthquake Mock Drill, NSS, Medical Health Camps, Village Health Tours, Extension services to the senior Citizens/Old age Home, Awareness Camps, Blood Donation Camps, transfer of technology/knowledge, Guest lecture & treatment of patients and distribution of free medicines etc. under the periodical monthly schedules were organized and practiced from time to time.

He then asked the Member Secretary to present the agenda for the meeting. The following agenda items were deliberated and resolved:

**Item No. 2: Approval of action taken report of the proceeding of 25<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council.**

The member secretary laid the action taken report on 25<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council after due deliberation the item was approved by the council unanimously.

**Item No. 3: Approval for the addition of new courses in 2018-19 under Chapter 1 of section 1.1 Sub-Section (i) and (ii) in Abhilashi University Academic regulation and approval of the syllabus thereof:**

The above new courses already approved may be adopted and inducted for implementation in the academic session 2018-19. The item was, thus, approved unanimously.

**Item No. 4: Approval for the revised M.B.A. & M.Sc. Zoology Syllabus:**

The Item submitted for revision of M.Sc. Zoology syllabus, after having duly recommended by the Board of Studies, has been approved with a remark that homogeneity in the syllabus with other institutions may be maintained to judiciously decide the cases of in-migration and out-migration. The same may be notified after necessary changes and conveyed to the Deans/HODs/In-charges for implementation.

At the same time, item for revision of the MBA syllabus has been deferred and referred back to the School of Management for reasons of inadequate information.

**Item No. 5: Academic Regulation Section 9.6 attendance eligibility for examination: Clause IV may be added as "On account of Sports, Cultural and NSS/Scots activities, the performers/participants/winners etc. may be given relaxation up to 10 (Ten) lectures or 10 days or 5 per cent but not exceeding overall limit of 15 per cent exemption".**

Since the overall limit of exemption already exists in the university regulation, the break-up of above stated relaxation may also be mentioned. Item is, therefore, approved and the same may be incorporated in the academic regulation under its relevant section & clause.

**Item No. 6: Similarly, Section 9.10 Part-H of Abhilashi University Academic Regulation devoted to Grading System formula (SGPA) may be corrected as enclosed.**

Necessary correction in the grading system formula SGPA/CGPA may be made as per the Annexure enclosed. However, the item for necessary additions & deletions in accordance with the guidelines of mandatory bodies specially in case of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture be referred back to COE for resolution & approval. At the same time, range of award percentage in section 9.10 sub clause-H in part - IV of the Regulation be improved and revised to confer the accurate semester grade point(SGPA) and the cumulative credit point average for all semesters (CGPA) to be expressed up to two decimal place. However, the matter of Grade point and Awards Percentage Range need to narrow down judiciously in the interest of students. This part of the agenda item is referred back to COE and Dean Faculty of Science for Sumiton.

**Item No. 7: To discuss/approve the adoption of the order notified vide File No. R-13040/33/2016-Tech.(Part) dt. 12-02-2018 issued by the Ministry of Ayus, Govt. of India, "To admit students in Ayus Under Graduate Courses from the Academic Session 2018-19 on the basis of the merit list of National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET) only". However, "the result of NEET (UG) may be utilized by entities of**

Central/State Governments for admission purpose in accordance with their rules”.

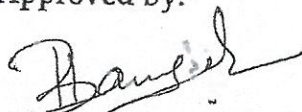

The Member Secretary being the convener of the meeting welcomed the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and all the members present in the meeting hall and thanked them for their valuable time for the meeting there after the agenda items were taken up.

**Item No. 1: Statement of the Vice-Chancellor:**

"I welcome all the Hon'ble members to this august Academic Council of Abhilashi University it is my privilege to inform you that my re-joining of this University, the University is making steady progress. The results of all the classes for the session 2019 -2020 are declared except B.A.M.S. and B.P.T. The admission process for the first year of different courses for the session 2020 - 21 is underway and I request all the members to use their personal contacts also so that more students show their interest in university and get admission. For the other classes the online system of teaching is running efficiently. I am personally monitoring the online classes system. Mid-Term examination for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> semester is conducted online from November 23<sup>rd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> November 2020.

A committee headed by Vice Chancellor of CSKHPKV Palampur visited the University on 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020 to access the infrastructure and other facilities for running B. Sc. and M. Sc. Agriculture courses. I am glad to inform this house that the committee has given favorable recommendations. University is now 6 years old but the goals set initially are still far away. The students strength dwindling and we need work hard to improve our teaching methods, making the delivery more convincing and attractive so that the students are convinced and satisfied because the students are the best ambassadors and their positive responses will certainly improve admissions to the university.

Since the university is six years old and as per the guidelines of the university grant commission accreditation of the university with a National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is mandatory. University is preparing/ collecting the relevant data to be submitted to the NAAC for accreditation. As also decided in the academic council meeting this is the right time the University has some kind of arrangements with other institutions for academic exchanges which will be beneficial to both the Institutions and to start the same steps are being taken initially to have MOU's with sister Institutions of the Group at Nerchowk. It is also desired that for the welfare of the surrounding and other communities short term courses / training programs of three to six months may also be initiated by the University which may be beneficial to the farming community and the general public overall as has been planned by the Govt. in its New Educational Policy 2020.

Now, I request the Registrar to take up the regular agenda".

The matter was deliberated and discussed in the meeting in detail and approved unanimously by the council and it was decided that the Controller of examination may be authorized to explore and conduct these examinations in mixed mode i.e. either offline or online pattern. It was also decided that keeping in view the necessity of the pass out students the reappear examinations for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> semester along with the regular and re appear examination of 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> semester. The even semester examination may be conducted after the completion of regular examinations and only in those subjects which the students apply for examination.

**Item No. 6: Any other item**

During the meeting the following non agenda items were also taken up and discussed as under:

- a. *Approval to re-designed Degree (except BAMS) and Diploma of the University:*  
In this regard the matter was taken up and the sample of the single language degree i.e. only in English was approved and it was decided that in future (after June 2018 onwards) all the degrees and diplomas will be issued in this new approved design i.e. in English only.
- b. Keeping in view the issuing of new syllabus for Diploma Pharmacy Allopathy by Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi, it was decided that as the admission process for current session is already under way the new syllabus will be implemented from the academic session 2021-22 onwards.
- c. The Council has unanimously resolved that the following course will be dropped/revived from Academic session 2021-22 and the HPPERC will be informed accordingly,
  - i) Courses to be revived
    1. B.Tech. (CSE)
  - ii) Courses to be dropped
    1. PGDCA
- d. The Academic Council unanimously approved the following MOUs signed in the month of October 2020 with retrospective effect,
  1. MOU signed between the Abhilashi University and the Abhilashi College of Education
  2. MOU signed between the Abhilashi University and the Abhilashi College of Pharmacy.It was further suggested that the University should explore more institutes for such MOUs which can benefit the students and faculty of University both.
- e. The various representations received from a student of Faculty of Agriculture/ Pharmacy regarding non submission of the sessional record/ synopsis and dissertations etc. due to COVID-19 situation and thus leading to non-declaration of result was taken up by the council and it was decided



to allow the students to apply for special permission on paying the prescribed fee for special examination so that their record is completed and result be declared.
