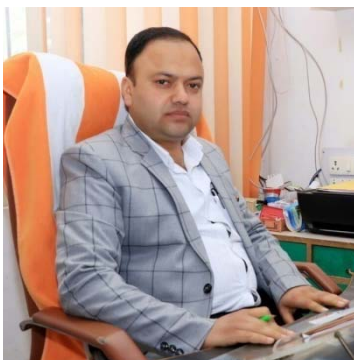

Abhilashi Group has gained a vast and fruitful experience in the field of education by establishing primer and diverse institutions during the period 2001 to 2020. The rich experience in such a short span of time, enabled the Abhilashi Educational Society to establish an independent Abhilashi University on 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2014. In 2001, Genius International Public School at Ner Chowk in Mandi district of Himachal Pradesh was the first institution established in affiliation with CBSE. Abhilashi P.G. College of Education at the same location was the second addition in affiliation with the Himachal Pradesh University in the year 2003. During 2006, Abhilashi Institute of Management Studies at Nerchowk, and Abhilashi College of Pharmacy at Balt (Tanda) were opened in affiliation to the Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. In 2007, Abhilashi Institute of Life Sciences was established in Balt (Tanda) in affiliation to the Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. Another School known as Chail Public School was started in 2013 at Chail Chowk which is affiliated to CBSE. Then, a major transformation in the field of higher education took place at Chail Chowk in Mandi District of Himachal Pradesh by establishing an independent Abhilashi University notified by the Government of Himachal Pradesh on 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 duly recognized by the University Grants Commission, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi. Since then, Abhilashi University not only added several professional courses but also diversified in multi-disciplinary academic and social activities. ## **4. Faculty of Agriculture**



### **a. School of Agriculture**

School of Agriculture has been established in Abhilashi University under Faculty of Science in 2014. This school is offering B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture (4-year course spread over 8 semesters) with an intake capacity of 120 students. Under the co-education system, the students are admitted to the course after an entrance test conducted by the university.

After going through common and elective courses in Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Basic Sciences during the degree programme, we have in the course curriculum a one year exposure of the students in complete rural settings where the students will go and live along with farm families in the villages and have the first-hand experience of their living, agricultural practices, difficulties and expectations. Students will be attached to an agriculture based industry in order to acquaint themselves with post-harvest processing of agriculture produce and link agriculture production with industry

The School of Agriculture is working with a vision and mission to fulfill threefold responsibility:

- To produce competent human resource.
- To educate the farming community regarding the modern techniques of agriculture so as to make the profession viable and remunerative.
- Continuing finding new technologies suiting to specific needs of the region through continued research.



- To promote the Agricultural education and research to disseminate knowledge in Agriculture/Forestry/Horticulture Sciences for sustainable and productive use of the produce for the welfare of society.
- To develop knowledge about the various agriculture, forestry, horticulture and vegetable crops for the enhancement of production and productivity of vegetables, cereals, horticulture commodities in the area.

### **Faculty Strength:**

## **FIELD ACTIVITIES PERFORMED BY STUDENTS**

**1 Maintenance of Departmental Polyhouse by students of Agriculture:** Along with theoretical classroom teaching, experiential education was also imparted to the students of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture. The operational activities required to start a polyhouse were also demonstrated to the student

2 The School of Agriculture has established an orchard in about 3 bighas land area which is now in its 3<sup>rd</sup> year developmental stage. There are 45 number of plants of different varieties of apple viz. Oregon Spur, Super Chief, Gale Gala, Granny Smith and Scarlet Spur are growing, of which Gale Gala and Super Chief came first time into full bearing after the establishment.

3 In fruit orchard, various other fruit crops are also grown namely:

- i) Pomegranate- Varieties: Kandhari, Kabuli (hard seeded) and Bhagwa (soft seeded)
- ii) Pear- Variety: Red Bartlett
- iii) Kiwi- Allison (Male variety) and Hayward (Female variety). This year, kiwi gave good yields and better quality fruits.
- iv) Persimmon-Variety: Fuyu (Non astringent)

Instead of these fruit crops; peach, nectarine, citrus, walnut and pecannut are also grown in the orchard. This year, flowering and fruit size in peach was improved. On an average 30-40 fruits per plant were produced. As part of the practical training, students of the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> semester of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture Programme of Abhilashi University, School of Agriculture, learned to plough and preparation of field for seed sowing, also using this walking type tractor (Power Tiller) in experimental plot by the 4th semester students.

4 Students were also equipped with following activities in Post Harvest Technology (PHT):

- Preparation of Tomato Jam
- Preparation of Apple Jam
- Tomato Ketchup Preparation
- Orange Squash Preparation
- RTS (Ready to Serve) Preparation



### **Educational tour to the Great Himalayan National Park and Hill Agricultural Research and Extension Centre Bajaura to Study about Various Environmental Assests.**

Educational tour was organized for the students of B.Sc. Agriculture 4th year on 04 November 2019. The motive of this tour was to provide practical knowledge regarding numerous flora and more than 375 fauna species, including approximately 31 mammals, 181 birds, 3 reptiles, 9 amphibians, 11 annelids, 17 mollusks and 127 insects, varieties, cultural practices and insect pest management of horticultural crops.

### **Vermicomposting**

In order to aware students about preparation and benefits of vermicompost, a vermicomposting unit was prepared in the vicinity of Abhilashi University. Best species of earthworms namely, *Esenia fetida* and *Eudrilus eugeniae* were used for the preparation of vermicompost. This compost takes 2-2.5 months time for use in agricultural fields and orchards.

## **EXTENSION EDUCATION ACTIVITIES**

In order to make students acquainted with horticulture and agriculture in rural hilly areas, various agricultural schemes/policies going on in villages, extension activities were organized. Farmers of adjoining areas were also educated about the modern techniques within their reach to make best use of their resources. This not only educated the farmers but provided an opportunity to the students to mingle with the farming community and have a firsthand feel of their difficulties and rural life.

Accordingly a series of extension activities which should be useful to the students, farmers as well as Faculty members were planned with the following objectives:

- To give an exposure to the students about the rural life and the local practices which the farmers are following. Also, they will have a practical session of growing Orchard, preparing the Vermicompost and fruit processing operations.
- To educate the farmers regarding the importance of Vermicomposting and demonstrate them the correct procedure of preparing Vermicompost.

In order to sharpen the knowledge and skills of agricultural students, Rural Agricultural Work Experience (RAWE) programme is offered in final year of B.Sc. (Hons.) The School of Agriculture was started a small unit of Oyster Mushroom in the month of October 2020 during pandemic condition. The Mushroom unit had planned by Dr. Alok Kumar, Dr. Ritika Singh and Mrs. Shivani Kaundal, Assistant Professor, School of Agriculture under the supervision of Dr. A.K. Gautam (Co-ordinator). The Pleurotus Mushroom is generally known as 'Oyster Mushroom' or 'Dhingri' in India. The Oyster Mushroom is one of the most suitable fungal organisms for producing protein rich food from various agro-wastes without composting. We have done 4-5 harvesting till December 18, 2020. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Registrar and Head of the department were inspected to Mushroom unit during preparation and harvesting.

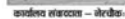
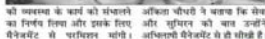

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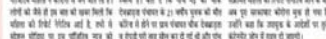
