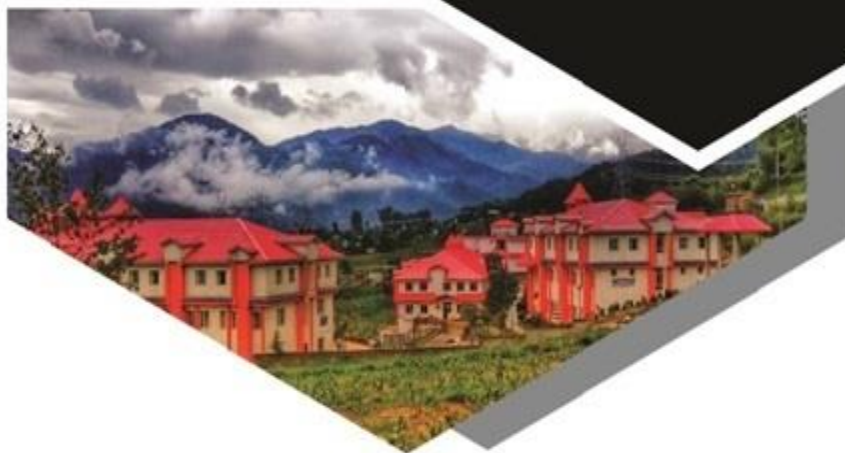

Abhilashi Group has gained a vast and fruitful experience in the field of education by establishing primer and diverse institutions during the period 2001 to 2020. The rich experience in such a short span of time, enabled the Abhilashi Educational Society to establish an independent Abhilashi University on 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2014. In 2001, Genius International Public School at Ner Chowk in Mandi district of Himachal Pradesh was the first institution established in affiliation with CBSE. Abhilashi P.G. College of Education at the same location was the second addition in affiliation with the Himachal Pradesh University in the year 2003. During 2006, Abhilashi Institute of Management Studies at Nerchowk, and Abhilashi College of Pharmacy at Balt (Tanda) were opened in affiliation to the Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. In 2007, Abhilashi Institute of Life Sciences was established in Balt (Tanda) in affiliation to the Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. Another School known as Chail Public School was started in 2013 at Chail Chowk which is affiliated to CBSE. Then, a major transformation in the field of higher education took place at Chail Chowk in Mandi District of Himachal Pradesh by establishing an independent Abhilashi University notified by the Government of Himachal Pradesh on 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 duly recognized by the University Grants Commission, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi. Since then, Abhilashi University not only added several professional courses but also diversified in multi-disciplinary academic and social activities. ## **4. Faculty of Agriculture**



### **a. School of Agriculture**

School of Agriculture has been established in Abhilashi University under Faculty of Science in 2014. This school is offering B.Sc.(Hons.) Agriculture (4-year course spread over 8 semesters) with an intake capacity of 120 students. Under the co-education system, the students are admitted to the course after an entrance test conducted by the university.

After going through common and elective courses in Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Basic Sciences during the degree programme, we have in the course curriculum a one year exposure of the students in complete rural settings where the students will go and live along with farm families in the villages and have the first-hand experience of their living, agricultural practices, difficulties and expectations. Students will be attached to an agriculture based industry in order to acquaint themselves with post-harvest processing of agriculture produce and link agriculture production with industry.

The School of Agriculture is working with a vision and mission to fulfill threefold responsibility:

- To produce competent human resource.
- To educate the farming community regarding the modern techniques of agriculture so as to make the profession viable and remunerative.

## **FIELD ACTIVITIES PERFORMED BY STUDENTS**

Instead of focusing only on teaching, attention was paid to the overall development of the student, in which things were explained to them with practical.

### **1. Collection of Specimen**

Students collected various plant specimens of ornamental use for preparation of herbarium.

### **2. Preparation of flax**

Students also prepared posters/ flex sowing different categories of ornamental plants viz., flowering annuals, trees, climbers, cacti & succulents, ornamental shrubs etc. They mounted these on the wall in the school of agriculture.

### **3. Breeding trial**

Linseed trial was laid using five different varieties of linseed namely Baner, Belinka, Nagarkot, Him Palam Alsi, KL-270

**4) Seed multiplication Trials along with crossing block were laid for linseed, wheat, pea and mustard**

**5) Crossing blocks were laid for demonstration of crossing techniques in different crops**

### **6.) Planning and layout of beds under polyhouse**

a.) Planning and layout for proper management of farm and development of managerial skill for B. Sc. Agriculture Students.

b.) Selection of crops and all necessary information related to cultivation practices was collected and planned accordingly.

### **7.) Tillage operations:**

a.) Tillage practices generally have their greatest effects on plant growth during germination, seedling emergence and stand establishment stages.

b.) The most common benefits of land preparation to most of crops are: Weed Control, increase in soil porosity.

c.) Field was ploughed 2-3 times and plots of convenient size were allotted among students and prepared by them before sowing.

d.) The implement used for these operations are power tiller, cultivators plough, plainers, hand roles, power sprayers, kudali and sikles etc.

### **8.) Identification of right stages of seedlings for transplanting:**

a.) Identify the detailed physical and morphological features of seed like color, size, shape and any other specific characters of seedlings.

- b.) Identify the right stage of seedlings for transplanting along with plant parts like leaf size, leaf shape and stem size, nodules and inter-nodes, branching etc.
- c.) Different stages can be identified by observing the best time of transplanting.

#### **9.) Weed Management:**

- a.) The weeding and hoeing cycles should be so arranged as to keep the field free from weeds.
- b.) All intercultural operations such as weeding, hoeing, topping and earthing-up etc. must be adhered to manner to optimize the overall productivity.
- c.) Right from the sowing time the weed management programme is initiated and spraying, hoeing and manual weeding is to be practiced to keep weed population under control as when desired.
- d.) Pre sown irrigation was given by students to maintain appropriate moisture for germination. Further the crop was irrigated at different growth stages, as and when required.

#### **10.) Fertilizer application:**

- a.) According to recommended doses of fertilizers, the fertilizers were applied firstly during sowing and after that at different stages.

#### **11.) Foliar application of nutrients:**

- a.) Application of nitrogen and micronutrients like zinc, boron etc for better growth of plants.

As fruit crops are also the largest area in Himachal. So the students were given practicals about fruits and how to manage them. Training and Pruning is very important for taking more fruit than any plant. Students were explained about it and practically they were told in the field

#### **12) Management practices in Orchard:**

- a.) Training and Pruning of Kiwi.
- b.) Intercultural operations like preparation of basin and manure application.
- c.) Foliar application of pesticides on apple tree.

#### **13) Observations:**

- a.) Different observations of fruit trees. Some trees were damaged either by high wind velocity or Pest attack like animals and humans.
- b.) a.) Different observations at different stages of crops (Cole crops, leafy Vegetables etc) were taken by students for their education purpose.

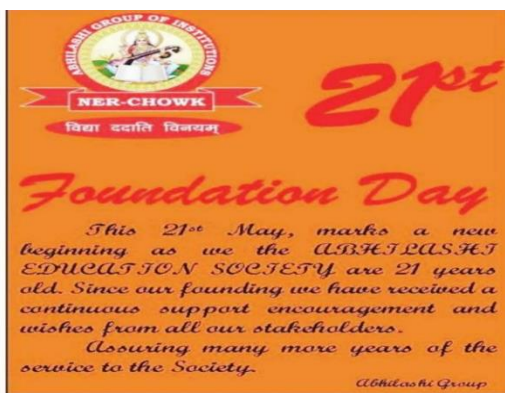

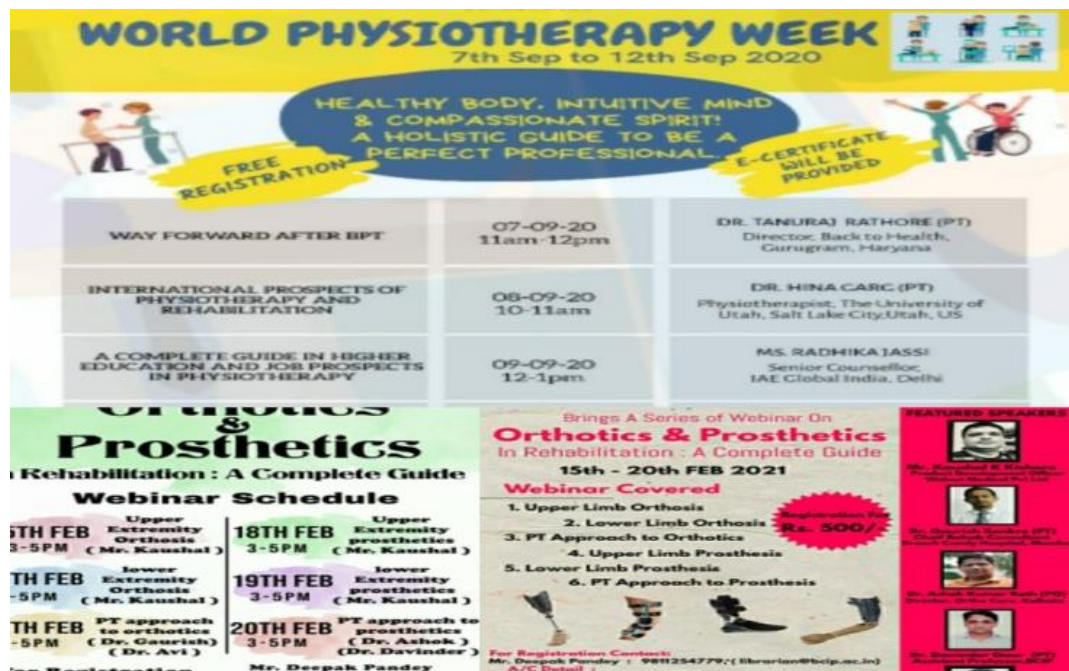

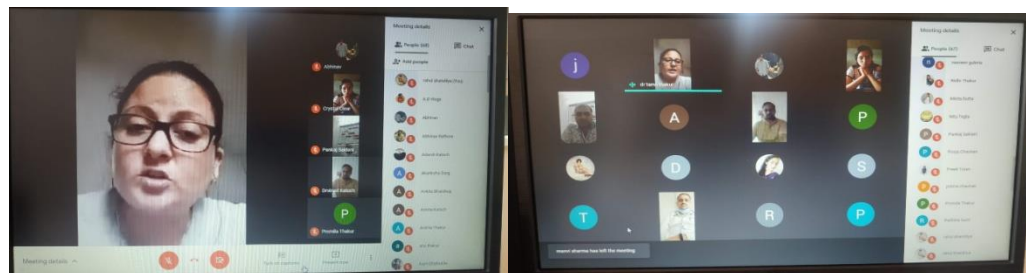


### Clinical application (OPD achievements):

Pro-Chancellor Dr.L.K Abhilashi said that success is challenging because it required translation of pharmacogenomics and pharmacology from the bench into the clinics.

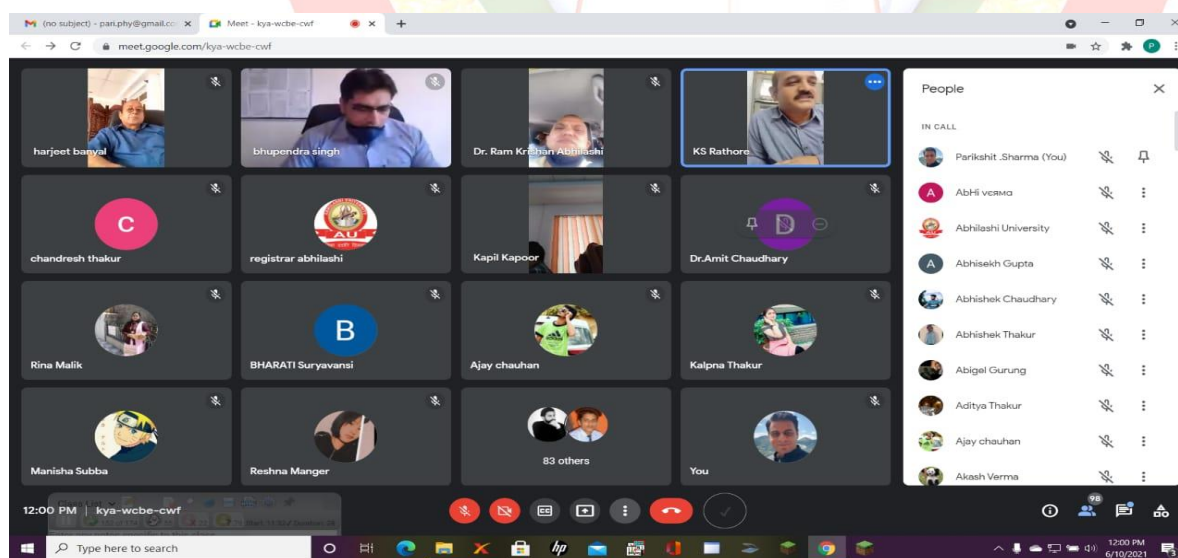

The field of science and genetics allows us to develop effective, safe medications, and doses tailored to an individual's genetic makeup what we call it today as "targeted therapy" which is either small-molecule drugs or monoclonal antibodies.

More than 100 Academicians, Professionals and PhD. researchers from different universities/colleges across the nation were present in this scientific webinar. At the end of webinar, the speakers also answered questions from various teachers and research students.

Dr. Amit Chaudhary, Dean-Faculty of Pharmacy also advocated bringing local needs and problems within the ambit of drug technology and development and thanked everyone.

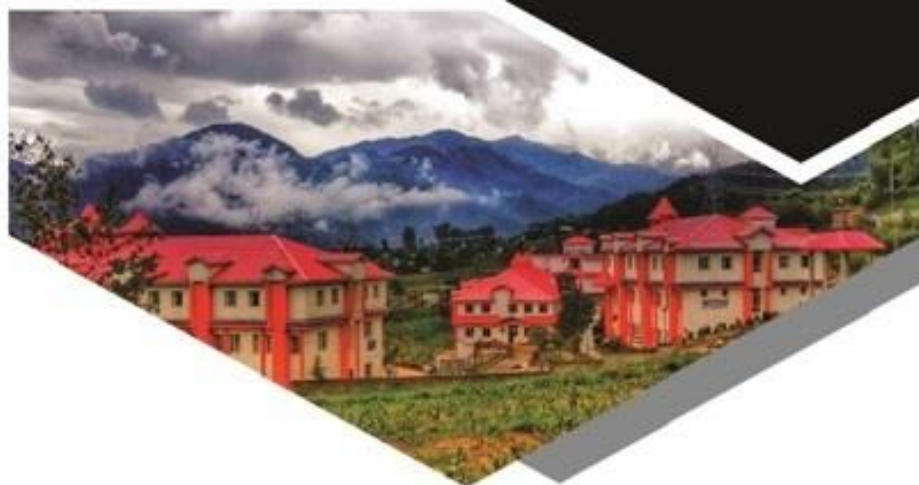
