**Plagiarism** is strictly prohibited in all academic materials created by our faculty members, and we ensure that only original contributions from our faculty and research scholars are sent to journals for publication. This determines the quality and originality of faculty member's academic contributions.

Mechanism for detecting plagiarism Institute recommended the need URKUND is a completely automated system against plagiarism (Anti-plagiarism software) software that can be used for checking plagiarism. This tool has been in effective use during the past 3 years. The quantity and quality of research articles have also improved substantially. The university also ensured that all research articles were checked for plagiarism before submitting the same to journals. The faculty and students send their article to the school and department URKUND representatives for checking their similarity index. Corrections were made as per the report and papers were submitted. Similar to research articles, all the Ph.D. thesis were checked for plagiarism and the report was endorsed by the department Coordinator before submission. This ensures that the plagiarism is less than 10 % before the thesis enters into the Shodhganga database. Supporting document is attached in the last of this report.

#### **Ethics Committee**

#### The Code of ethics for research

The concept of "Research" means to find out the solutions or the possible outcomes again and again. Research can be defined as the process of investigation which includes collection, documentation, analysis and interpretation of data/information with the use of appropriate scientific methodologies. A good research includes a systematic approach to capture accurate data. To achieve the goal of a good research, researchers need to practice ethics and a code of conduct while making observations or drawing conclusions.

Ethics in research includes set of standards, values and institutional arrangements to constituting and regulate research activities. Honesty in research, responsibility to colleagues, other people, animals, the environment and society in the widest sense should be mainly focused during conducting research. Keeping in view the importance of research in welfare of society and environment, every institution has some basic rules and regulations as well as some ethical guidelines to carry out standard research.

Abhilashi University established a code of ethics for conducting quality research mainly focused on scientific integrity, truthfulness, and accountability. The codes of ethics established

1. The research should be exploratory, descriptive and explanatory.

- 2. There should be honesty, objectivity, carefulness, openness, confidentiality in conducting
- 3. The research information provided by the researchers must be accurate and correct and should be compatible with sustainable development.

4. Researchers must protect the privacy of their research subjects.

- 5. Researchers must comply with national and international rules and regulations established to safeguard ethical and safety interests. Due care and respect to animal welfare should be kept in mind during preparing and conducting experiment involving
- 6. Special care should be taken by researchers during publication of research. The manuscripts prepared by researchers should be free from any type of plagiarism. In addition, researchers must take responsible publication, responsible mentoring, social responsibility, competence, legality, and human subjects protection.

7. Researchers must respect the contributions of other researchers and observe standards of
