Tobacco use is the single largest cause of preventable deaths and illness worldwide and kills half of its users prematurely, in their most productive age. As per the Global Youth Tobacco Survey (GYTS), 2009, students in India aged between 13 to 15 years, use tobacco in any form. According to the Global Adult Tobacco Survey (2016-17), adults 15 year and above in India use tobacco. The tobacco epidemic is estimated to impact about 27 crore tobacco users, mostly younger generation. On dated 26/03/2022 the Abhilashi University, Chail Chowk, Mandi was declared Tobacco-Free Institution/Campus by the Department Of Health And Family Welfare, Govt. of Himachal Pradesh. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. H.S. Banyal, Registrar Kapil Kapoor, Dr. Sachin Goyal, Dr. D.K. Misra and Dr. Parikshit Sharma were present during this event. 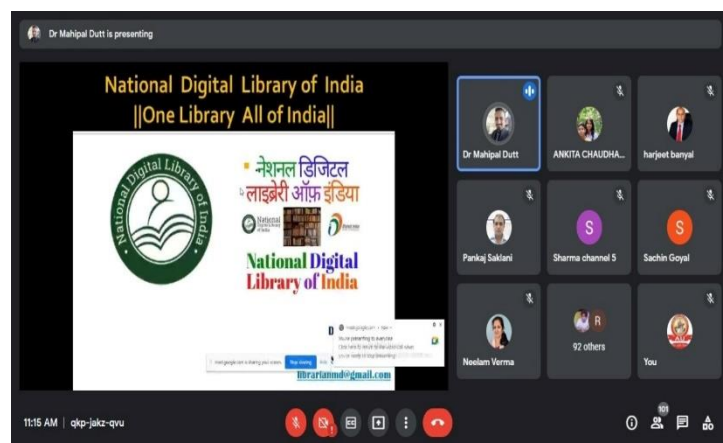
SCHOOL OF VETERINARY IN SHIVRATRI FAIR

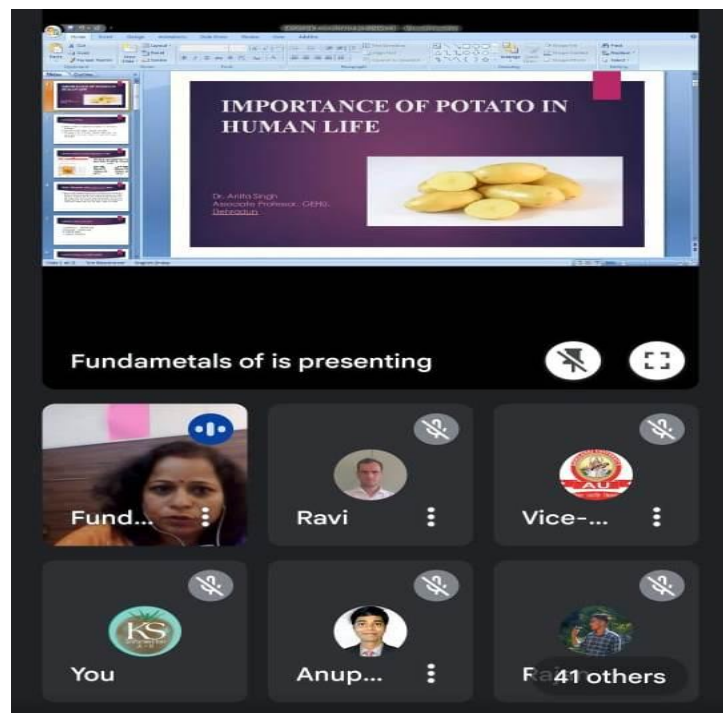

ENGINEERS DAY CELEBRATED ON THE CAMPUS

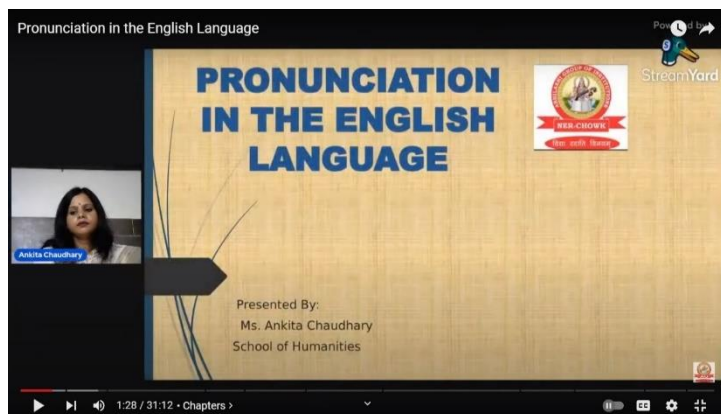

UNIVERSITY ORGANISED VILLAGE ATTACHMENT PROGRAM

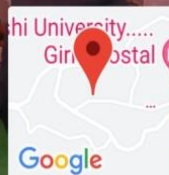
