Subsequently, Deputy Director Dr. Ashwani Thakur, outlined the agenda items for the meeting and sought the members' approval for the proposed discussions.

### **Item 1: To review the progress in AQAR for the Academic session 2024-25**

All criteria heads presented their progress relating to AQAR 2024-25 and identified key areas which needs further attention. Associated members were requested to work diligently to ensure the timely and efficient consolidation of the AQAR 2024-25.

### **Item 2: Launch of Multidisciplinary Academic Innovation Hub (MAIH) for curriculum enrichment and research advancement**

To elevate the existing research capabilities and meaningful research advancement, a Multidisciplinary Academic Innovation Hub (MAIH) needs to be established within the campus. Such a hub can serve as a collaborative platform, integrating diverse academic disciplines to drive innovation, enhance curriculum relevance, and create interdisciplinary research. It will also align with the vision of transforming the institution into a research-intensive center of excellence.

### **Item 3: Progress in systematic collection of structured feedback from all stakeholders and action taken**

The role of Criteria Head 1 was duly appreciated for the significant progress made in systematic collection of structured feedback from all key stakeholders—students, faculty, alumni, and parents. To facilitate this, a digitized form aligned with NAAC guidelines was adopted and circulated in the first week of April. The response rate has improved significantly this time, with a substantial volume of data collected as a result of proactive follow-up and effective sensitization efforts.

**Item 4: Green campus initiative and waste management system**



Furthermore, they were asked to identify the specific ICT tools and resources that are additionally required to bridge the existing gaps.
