**Welcome Address by Director, IQAC**

The IQAC meeting began with an appreciation of the Criteria Heads and associated members for their dedication toward ensuring academic excellence in the University. Prof. P. C. Sharma, Director IQAC, welcomed all attendees and acknowledged their commitment to institutional growth. He highlighted the prominent role of each IQAC member in achieving the academic excellence and expressed confidence in attaining desired outcomes through collective efforts. Subsequently, Dr. Ashwani Thakur, Deputy Director IQAC, presented the meeting agenda items for discussion and sought their approval.

**Agenda 1: To review the progress in AQAR for academic session 2024-25**

Criteria Heads were reminded that the deadline for submission of AQAR 2024–25 is 31<sup>st</sup> Dec. 2025, after approval by the Academic Council. Therefore, it was unanimously decided that AQAR should be prepared by **15<sup>th</sup> December 2025**, so that the consolidated criteria-wise information can be made available to the Vice-Chancellor's office in time.

**Agenda 2: Implementing sustainable green practices**

Due emphasis was placed on adopting green, sustainable practices and effective waste management. To achieve this, it was decided that active contribution from every student, faculty member, and the local community should be ensured in coming time.

**Agenda 3: Pre-Activity Information to the IQAC office**

Prior information is desired to submit and due approval must be obtained from the IQAC office before organizing any activity in the University, to ensure smoother and more effective functioning of the office.

**Agenda 4: Organising various awareness and career counselling programmes**

It was proposed that regular programs on drug abuse and the adverse impacts of ragging should be organized to create awareness among students. In addition, career-counselling and guidance sessions must be conducted to prepare them for future challenges.

**Agenda 5: To Set up additional ICT-enabled classrooms to make teaching and learning more engaging and interactive**

The house realized that there is a need to establish more ICT-enabled classrooms in coming time to enhance the teaching-learning experience. Such classrooms make the content more engaging and interactive. Expanding ICT infrastructure will foster better understanding and active participation among students.

**Agenda 6: Accessibility of plagiarism checking tools**


The members highlighted the need for access to plagiarism-checking softwares and requested that priority be given to making it available to all research supervisors.

**Agenda 7: Students and teachers should complete short-term courses on SWAYAM/NPTEL to enhance their knowledge and skills**

The house firmly agreed on significant need to encourage students and teachers to enrol in and complete short-term courses available on SWAYAM/NPTEL platforms. These courses, covering a wide range of contemporary subjects based upon Indian knowledge system (IKS) and skills, provide an opportunity to stay updated with the latest and conventional knowledge in the relevant fields. Upon successful completion of these courses, the scores will be recorded and reflected in their respective Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) accounts, providing a measurable recognition of their learning progress and skill development. This initiative aims to foster a culture of continuous learning and self-improvement within the institution.
