This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made effective on this 11th day of April, 2025, between **Regional Ayurveda Research Institute (RARI), Mandi**, a research institution under the Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India, located at Pandoh, Mandi, Himachal Pradesh – 175124, represented through its Authorized Signatory **Dr. Vineeta Kumari Negi, In-charge, RARI, Mandi**, hereinafter referred to as "RARI, Mandi" or "First Party" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successors and permitted assigns).

AND

Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute (a department of Abhilashi University), Chailchowk, located at Chailchowk, Mandi, Himachal Pradesh, represented through its Authorized Signatory **Dr. Divya Deepak, Principal, Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Chailchowk**, hereinafter referred to as "Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Chailchowk" or "Second Party" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successors and permitted assigns).

The First Party and the Second Party shall hereinafter be referred to individually as "Party" and collectively as "Parties".

1. OBJECTIVES

This MoU establishes a scientific and academic collaboration framework between RARI, Mandi and Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Abhilashi University, Chailchowk in Ayurveda, Ethnobotany, Integrative Medicine, and Advanced Scientific Research.

The objectives include:

1. Academic Collaboration – Developing joint academic programs, training, and capacity-building initiatives.
2. Collaborative Research– Conducting interdisciplinary research on Ayurveda, Veterinary, Biotechnology, Bioinformatics, and Artificial Intelligence (AI) in Ayurveda.
3. Technology Development – Advancing Ayurvedic AI models, digital health platforms, and integrative medicine technologies.

4. Joint Intellectual Property (IP) and Publications – Co-authorship in research papers, patent, and technology transfers.
5. Social Awareness & Capacity Building – Organizing workshops, training programs, and national/international conferences.
6. Exchange Programs – Facilitating student, faculty, and scientist exchange.
7. Evidence-Based Ayurveda– Conducting clinical and preclinical research to validate Ayurvedic treatments scientifically.

2. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

1. Research & Development:

- Development of innovative Ayurvedic formulations and herbal extracts.
- Conducting ethnobotanical surveys to document medicinal plants in Himachal Pradesh.
- Research on anti-ageing, longevity, and integrative medicine.
- Joint research facilities with access to high-performance computing, bioinformatics, and pharmacology labs.

2. Clinical Research & Ayurveda Validation:

- Conducting clinical trials on Ayurveda-based interventions for chronic and lifestyle disorders.
- Validation of Ayurvedic diagnostics using modern scientific tools and AI-driven analysis.
- Conducting clinical trials on Ayurveda-based interventions in Veterinary Sciences.

3. Technology & Start-up Support:

- Supporting Ayurvedic start-ups through incubation.
- Developing Ayurvedic digital health platforms, mobile apps, and telemedicine solutions.

4. Intellectual Property & Commercialization:

- Co-ownership of patents, copyrights, and trademarks for jointly developed innovations.
- Licensing technologies for commercial use in collaboration with industry partners.

3. NATURE

1. This MoU is non-exclusive in nature. Parties shall be free to enter into similar MoU's with any other Party during currency or the extended currency of this MoU.
2. This MoU is an expression of the intention of both the Parties to engage in academia-industry-research collaborations, as may be agreed by mutual consent from time to time, by separate instruments in writing, with each such instrument containing details of specific activities to be undertaken in collaboration.

4. FINANCIALS

1. This MoU does not impose financial obligations on either Party.
2. Funding for specific research projects shall be obtained through government grants, industry sponsorships, or joint proposals.

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3. Financial aspects related to patent filing, product development, and clinical research shall be discussed separately.

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5. RELATIONSHIP

1. It is expressly agreed that the Parties shall be independent contractors and that the relationship between the Parties shall not be constituted a partnership, joint venture or agency. Neither Party shall have the authority to make any statements, representations or commitments of any kind, or to take any action, which shall be binding on the other Party, without the prior consent of such other Party. Word "Partner", if used anywhere, throughout this MoU, is for the reference purposes and doesn't create a partnership relationship under the law.
2. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties except confidentiality and IPR Clause. The acts/performance and actions taken by either party in furtherance of their respective activities of operation shall not bind the other except to the extent provided under this MoU. The acts performed and action taken by either party that do not fall under the MoU shall have binding effect on the other to the extent they are reduced to writing and the prior consent of the other party is obtained.
3. Any information furnished by either of the parties shall be treated as strictly confidential and shall not be disclosed by either of the parties.
4. Each party hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold the other party harmless from any and against all claims, demands, cause of action, liabilities, losses, damages, cost and NOTARY PUBLIC expenses awarded against or incurred arising directly and/or indirectly from a breach of this MoU, including but not limited to, omissions, commissions, negligence and default by the other party.
5. No failure, delay, relaxation or indulgence by any party in exercising any right conferred on such party by this MoU shall operate as a waiver of such right, nor shall any single or partial exercise of any such right nor any single failure to do so, preclude any other or future exercise of it, or the exercise of any other right under this MoU.

6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

1. Title to all inventions, discoveries, or developments made solely by the researchers of each Party shall reside in that Party; title to all inventions, discoveries, developments, or other intellectual property including but not limited to copyrights, patents and industrial designs made jointly by the Parties, under this Agreement shall be jointly owned by the Parties.
2. RARI, Mandi and Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Abhilashi University, Chailchowk will have the right to continue utilizing the intellectual property generated as part of the R&D work carried out under this MoU for its research and teaching purposes only.
3. RARI, Mandi and Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Abhilashi University, Chailchowk will enter into a license agreement if there is a possibility of commercialization of results arising out of research conducted under this agreement. Benefits arising out of such commercialization shall be shared between RARI, Mandi and Abhilashi Ayurvedic

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College & Research Institute, Abhilashi University, Chailchowk under mutually agreed terms.

4. In the event that the RARI, Mandi is not interested in the Offer, then RARI, Mandi/ Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Abhilashi University, Chailchowk, as the case may be, will be free to license the results to other third parties based on mutual consent.
5. Protection of any intellectual property and publication of results arising out of this Agreement will be mutually discussed and agreed to.

7. HANDLING OF BIOLOGICAL MATERIALS

1. Each Party shall ensure that any collection, handling, transportation, and retention of any human biological materials, including, but not limited to, blood, body tissue, plasma and any other material containing human cells (the "Biological Materials"), if applicable, is carried out in accordance with the Protocol and all Applicable Laws.
2. Each Party shall ensure that the security, integrity, and quality of the Biological Materials are maintained at all times. Each Party shall be responsible for maintaining its own chain of custody to allow traceability and management of the Biological Materials.

8. HANDLING OF PATIENT DATA/DIGITAL INFORMATION (RADIOLOGICAL IMAGES/PATHOLOGICAL IMAGES IN ANY FORM)

1. Each Party shall ensure that any collection of Patient Data/Digital Information (Radiological Images/Pathological images in any form), if applicable, is carried out in accordance with the Protocol and all Applicable Laws. RARI Mandi, on its behalf, and on behalf of its principal investigators, agrees and acknowledges that Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Abhilashi University, Chailchowk, may use the Patient Data/Digital Information (Radiological Images/Pathological images in any form) to conduct secondary research, subject to in accordance with the Applicable Laws.
2. Each Party shall ensure that the security, integrity, and quality of the Patient Data/Digital Information (Radiological Images/Pathological images in any form) are maintained at all times. Each Party shall be responsible for maintaining its own chain of custody to allow traceability and management of the Patient Data/Digital Information (Radiological Images/Pathological images in any form).
3. The ownership of the Patient Data/Digital Information (Radiological Images/Pathological images in any form) collected during and for the Study shall vest with RARI, Mandi. Abhilashi Ayurvedic College & Research Institute, Abhilashi University, Chailchowk will not use this information in any form for any other studies apart from the studies conducted under this agreement.

9. FORCE MAJEURE

1. The Parties shall not be liable for any failure to perform, any of its obligations under this MoU if the performance is prevented, hindered or delayed by a *Force Majeure* event (defined below) and in such case its obligations shall be suspended for so long as the Force Majeure Event continues.

2. "Force Majeure Event" means an event which is beyond the reasonable control of the Parties concerned, including, without limitation, unavailability of any communication system, sabotage, fire, flood, explosion, acts of God, civil commotion, strikes or industrial action of any kind, riots, insurrection, war or acts of government etc.
3. Each party shall promptly inform the other of the existence of a Force Majeure event and shall consult together to find a mutually acceptable solution.

11. GOVERNING LAW

1. The MoU shall be interpreted in accordance with and governed by the applicable laws in India.
2. Notwithstanding the above, the scope of this MoU shall automatically become null and void to the extent it is in violation or in contradiction to the provisions of the concerned Act, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations of the CCRAS.
3. If any provision of this MoU is held invalid, unenforceable or illegal for any reason, this MoU will remain otherwise in full force apart from that provision (s) which shall be deemed deleted.
4. This MoU shall be governed by the laws of the Republic of India and subject to the jurisdiction of courts in Mandi. HP.

12. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

1. It is hereby agreed by and between the parties that if any controversy, dispute or difference shall arise concerning construction, meaning, violation, termination, validity or nullity including without limitation the scope of any clause or effect of this MoU or any part thereof, or of the respective rights or liabilities herein contained, the parties shall resolve the same by mutual discussion or mediation. However, if the parties here to fail to resolve the controversy, dispute or difference amicably within 15 (fifteen) days of commencement of discussions, conciliation or mediation, then any party shall upon expiry of such period of 15 (fifteen) days be entitled to refer such controversy, dispute or difference to be resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and

Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modifications on re-enactment thereof as in force.

2. In any arbitration commenced pursuant to this clause, the sole arbitrator shall be appointed by the mutual consent of the parties as per the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996
3. The language to be used in the arbitration proceeding shall be in Hindi and English. The seat or place of arbitration shall be at Shimla, Himachal Pradesh. The cost of arbitration proceedings shall be shared equally by both the parties. Arbitral award shall be acceptable to both the parties.

13. AMENDMENT

1. Any amendments to this Agreement shall be made by mutual consent, written and signed by both the Parties hereto, except that each Party can make a change of the name of the SPOC person, for which mere notice to the other party shall serve the purpose.

14. NOTICE

1. Notices hereunder must be in writing and given to the other Party by in-hand delivery; by electronic mail; by facsimile; by first-class mail, postage prepaid; or by air courier to the mailing address set forth above or to such other address as either Party may designate. Notices shall be effective when received.

15. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

1. This agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties with regard to provision of the services and supersedes all previous correspondence / agreements / understanding. Any amendment, modification, change or revision to this agreement as mutually agreed between the Parties hereto shall be made in writing.

16. ASSIGNMENT

1. No Party shall transfer its rights and obligations hereunder to any third party without prior written consent of the Party hereto.

17. CONFIDENTIALITY

1. For the purpose of this Agreement "Confidential Information" means any and all data and information including, intellectual property, anonymized study participant data, technical, business, marketing, policy, know how, planning, project management and other information which is designated to be confidential or by its nature intended to be for the knowledge of the Receiving Party or client/customer data disclosed by a Disclosing Party to a Receiving Party in tangible form whether or not marked as confidential or, or any oral or visual representation thereof, whether or not identified as confidential at the time of disclosure of the Disclosing Party, irrespective of where such data and information was developed or generated. In particular, Confidential Information shall include, without limitation:

- a. data and information relating to clinical data of the study participants; and

- b. any intellectual property belonging to any Party relating to the Study.
2. At all times during the term of this Agreement and thereafter, each Party receiving (the "Receiving Party") Confidential Information shall, and shall cause its officers, members, and other employees and agents to, keep confidential and not publish or otherwise disclose and not use, directly or indirectly, for any purpose, any Confidential Information provided to it by the other Party (the "Disclosing Party"), except to the extent such disclosure or use is expressly permitted by the terms of this Agreement.
3. The Parties hereto promise and agree to respect the intellectual property rights and confidentiality of all information, maps, designs, data and other documents as may be made available to the Parties and shared between them, and to use said information solely and exclusively for performance of any Studies done under purview of this MoU and to refrain from and prevent the dissemination or distribution of such information to third parties without the prior written consent of the disclosing/competent party throughout the term of this Agreement (including any renewal thereof)
4. This confidentiality undertaking does not apply to any:
- information which has been published other than through a breach of this undertaking;
 - information lawfully in the possession of the recipient Party before its disclosure in the Study took place;
 - information obtained from a third party who is/was free to disclose it;
 - information independently developed by a Party; or
 - information which a Party is requested to disclose and required by law (including a regulatory body) to disclose.
4. The Receiving Party agrees to maintain the Confidential Information using the same or greater degree of care it uses with its own most highly sensitive information (but in no event less than a reasonable degree of care) to protect the information from unauthorized use, access and disclosure.
5. Upon the termination or expiration of this Agreement or upon a Disclosing Party's earlier request, the Receiving Party shall promptly return to the Disclosing Party all of its respective Confidential Information, provided, that, the Receiving Party shall have the right to retain, subject to the other provisions of this Agreement, a copy of any Study documentation to the extent required by applicable laws.

18. NO WAIVER

1. No failure or delay by either Party in exercising or enforcing any right, remedy or power hereunder shall operate as a waiver thereof, nor shall any single or partial exercise or enforcement of any right, remedy or power preclude any further exercise or enforcement thereof or the exercise or enforcement of any other right, remedy or power. The failure of either Party to enforce its rights under this Agreement at any time for any period shall not be construed as a waiver of such rights.

20. ETHICS

1. Any study that will be undertaken under this MoU will require ethical clearances from respective institutes/parties.

21. TERM & TERMINATION

1. The MoU shall come into force immediately upon its signing by the parties and will be in force for an initial period of four (4) years. MoU can be extended further on the mutually agreed terms.
2. This MoU may be terminated by mutual consent of the parties before the aforesaid term of four (4) years.
3. Either of the parties can terminate this MoU by giving advance notice of one (01) month period without jeopardizing the ongoing collaborative undertakings.

This Memorandum of Understanding is executed on this 3rd day of October, 2023 (herein after referred as the "Execution Date") by and between

Abhilashi University, Chailchowk, Distt. Mandi – 175045 (H.P.) (herein after called "AU"), represented by the Registrar, Dr. Kapil Kapoor, established as a State Private University by the Government of Himachal Pradesh vide Abhilashi University (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2014.

and

Baba Mastnath University, Asthal Bohar, NH-10, Rohtak, Haryana -124021 (herein after called "BMU"), represented by the Registrar, Dr. Manoj Kumar established as a State Private University by the Government of Haryana in 2012 vide Haryana Private Universities Act 2006.

Purpose of Memorandum of Understanding

With reference to establish the academic relations between the two institutions, both parties emphasize the scientific and academic interaction between both the institutions and they both agree to initiate a scientific cooperation and exchange of staff and students in order to achieve a consolidated partnership between their members and departments at faculty level.

This Memorandum of Understanding is designed to facilitate the advancement and intensification of academic cooperation between both partner institutes. Activities would include but would not be limited to:-

1. Joint research activities and publications

2. Exchange of academic information and materials in the field of interest to both the institutions
3. Exchange of faculty members/research scholars/students based on the projects and research needs
4. Utilization of library resources and laboratory facilities according to the research need
5. Mentoring or technical support
6. Cooperation in syllabi development for academic and professional programmes
7. Jointly organize research and academic activities like seminar/conference/workshop etc.
8. Design of effective Research, Clinical Internship
9. Clinical hand to hand training programmes

Terms and Agreement

1. The parties will manage their own financial liabilities, aroused out of collaborative academic and scientific activities.
2. During the tenure of the MoU, the parties agree to respect confidentiality of any work or material provided in confidence.
3. IPR titles or ownership of any product, proprietary information or technology tools, processes and methodology for any deliverable, new ideas, inventions or development, conceived developed or prepared jointly by the AU and BMU under the ambit of this MoU shall remain the property of both the parties, as agreed mutually. This clause shall remain valid even after the termination or expiry of this MoU.

Amendments

This Memorandum may be amended or modified by mutual consent and the exchange of letters between the two parties. Such amendments, once approved by both institutions, will become part of this Memorandum.

Duration and Termination

This Agreement shall be effective upon the last signature by the representatives of both the institutions and shall be in force for three years.

This agreement can be renewed if the parties agree in writing for a renewal.

5. To provide local hospitality to the representatives when visiting collaborating institutions, if agreed to in advance.

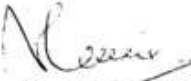
GENERAL PROVISIONS OF THE MoU

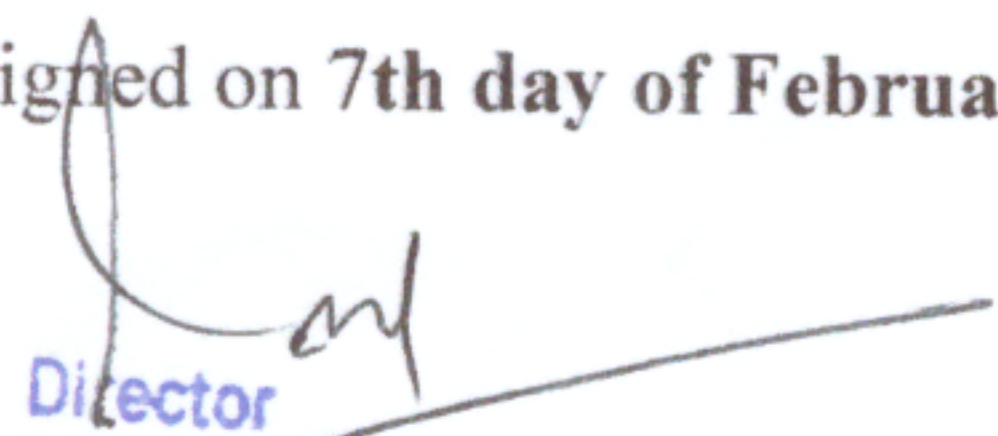
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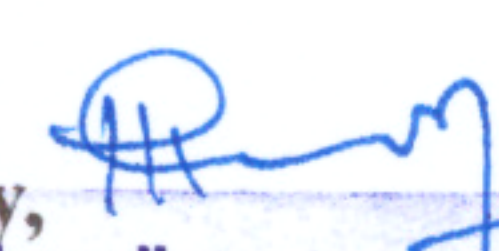
